

20) What's AIM?

AIM is a mandatory attendance improvement program. If a student receives 3 or more unexcused absences or is tardy 5 times to any one class, they are assigned to the AIM program. Once in the AIM program they are on “attendance watch” and in the AIM program for the semester. This is a 3-level progressive program.

- 1st Level – Until a student completes their 10 days in the after-school AIM class, they will not be allowed to perform in, participate in, or compete in extra-curricular activities. If a student receives any more unexcused absences or is tardy in any class, he/she will be assigned the second level of AIM.
- 2nd Level – Saturday School is assigned. If a student receives any more unexcused absences or is tardy, he/she will be assigned the third level of AIM.
- 3rd Level – 5 more hours after school in the AIM class. A meeting with a school administrator may be scheduled.
