## Student Success Team (SST)

### What's an SST?

*How do I get one?*

*SST stands for Student Success Team and this is a conference held for parents, students and teachers, facilitated by our counselor. The discussion in the meeting revolves around student performance and a support plan can be developed. SST's are set up automatically after grading periods when students are failing classes. A parent, or a teacher or an administrator can request an SST by making a request through the guidance department. A follow-up meeting is suggested to monitor the plan's effectiveness.*
